Dear Calgary Catholic residents of the St. Isabella School boundary community,

On April 6, 2017 the boundary decision was communicated to the St. Isabella School community regarding the new All Saints High School. The new boundaries were developed through the district's Help Plan Our Future (HPOF) process involving several public participation sessions and committee recommendations from trustees, parents and district staff.

All Saints High School is scheduled to open with grades 10 and 11 students only. Starting smaller is intentional, and because of this approach, it provides the opportunity to support parents/students residing in the St. Isabella School community. Although the All Saints High School boundary maps, developed through the HPOF process, will serve our South Catholic High School well for many years, the following opportunity is now confirmed:

- Students residing in the St. Isabella School boundary area will have the choice to attend All Saints High School or their designated school – Bishop O'Byrne High School.
- This opportunity will be in place for three years, with a commitment to continue to provide transportation to All Saints High School for any student from the St. Isabella School community already admitted to the school. For example, if a student is in his/her Grade 11 year and the opportunity to attend All Saints is discontinued, the student will be supported to finish Grade 12 at All Saints High School.
- The choice of attending All Saints High School is also available for St. Isabella School students wishing to enroll in All Saint's district designated programs of Extended French and Advanced Placement.
- In the third year of operation (2020/2021 school year) the opportunity for St. Isabella students to attend All Saints will be reviewed to determine if it can continue or not.
- If future enrolment numbers at All Saints High School do not allow this opportunity to continue, all students residing in the St. Isabella boundary area will attend their designated high school Bishop O'Byrne.
