MEDICATION

For various reasons, some students are required to take prescribed medication administered by school personnel during the school day. If your child requires medication it is necessary to provide medical forms completed by a doctor and parent. It is the parent's legal responsibility to advise the school of severe medical needs such as severe allergies or other medical conditions that

may require the administration of medication by school staff. If your child requires an EpiPen, they are to always have one with them and one in the office. The required forms can be obtained at the front office or you can email the office and we will send you copies of these forms.

ALLERGY SAFE ENVIRONMENT

While school administrators and staff continually work towards an allergy-safe environment, an "allergen-free" or "peanut-free" milieu with zero risk cannot be reasonably guaranteed. Students are asked not to share snacks, treats or lunches with other students in the school. Prevention is the best approach for reducing the risk of severe allergic reactions. Therefore, we are requesting cooperation in refraining from sending food products to school which contain peanut or nut products.
