## WHAT PARENTS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT EXECUTIVE FUNCTIONING: PRACTICAL STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS AT HOME AND SCHOOL

Executive functioning skills are a group of skills that allow children to manage their thoughts, actions and emotions in order to “get things done”. These skills include: paying attention, organizing and planning, starting tasks and staying focused on them, regulating emotions, and self-monitoring. Issues with executive functioning can make it hard for children to complete school work and everyday tasks.

Parents and other caregivers play an essential role in helping children develop executive functioning skills from early childhood through adolescence. During this presentation, parents will learn practical strategies to improve their child’s executive functioning skills for greater success at home and school.
