Dear Parents of Don Bosco Students Who Reside in the St. Isabella Boundary Area,

In a letter to parents dated June 18, 2015 regarding restricted enrolment reconsideration for St. Isabella School, there was a change in the designated school for students residing within the St. Isabella boundary area. The letter stated:

- *Blessed Cardinal Newman School becomes the district-designated school for redirected students that live in the St. Isabella boundary area. District transportation provided.*
- *Restricted enrolment procedures remain in effect at St. Isabella School with waitlists maintained to determine when students can be repatriated to their home school.*

On February 8, update letters were provided to the new Auburn Bay, south Cranston and New Brighton school communities indicating that the schools would be opening for September 2016. As indicated in our June 18, 2015 letter, the designated school for your child for the 2016-2017 school year is Blessed Cardinal Newman. Should you prefer your child remain at Don Bosco, please contact the school office to inform us of this choice as soon as possible. Note that district transportation to Don Bosco School will not be provided. For all other current Don Bosco students from the St. Isabella School area, they will be automatically re-directed to Blessed Cardinal Newman School for next year. In addition, the wait list procedures for St. Isabella School remain in place, allowing for limited students to return to St. Isabella School based on available room and resources.
