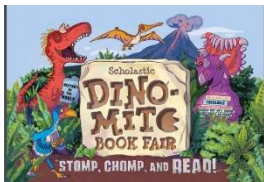
### REMINDER - TEDDY BEAR DAY (KINDERGARTEN)

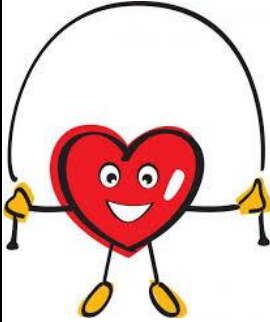
## **CANTEEN AND HOT LUNCHES**
