Dear Parents of the Christ the King School Boundary Community,

The following information pertains to new procedures the district and school administration will be following regarding restricted enrolment at Christ the King School. Please note that this information does not influence current students attending Christ the King School and their younger siblings.

On April 27, 2017, restricted enrolment procedures were implemented at Christ the King School. This was expected based on the Help Plan Our Future public participation decisions that were determined two years previous (June 18, 2015) in preparation for the opening of Our Lady of the Rosary School. In the April 27, 2017 decision letter, it stated:

“In its ongoing planning efforts, the district will continue to review population and transportation trends at Our Lady of the Rosary and Christ the King on an annual basis. As necessary, we will engage the community when potential revisions are required.”

On March 20, 2018, district and school administration met with current and future parents from the Christ the King School community who have been redirected to Our Lady of the Rosary School. Thank you to all participants who attended this meeting for their valuable comments, recommendations and feedback. Based on the review of current and future population trends for Christ the King School, the opportunity to open spaces for students is now available.

Therefore, the following revisions to the restricted growth procedures at Christ the King School have now been implemented effective immediately:

- All current and preregistered students at Our Lady of the Rosary School from North Cranston as of March 20, 2018 are offered registration spots for September 2018 at Christ the King School.
- All future siblings of these students are able to attend Christ the King School when they are of school age (must confirm their preregistration at Christ the King School by May 4, 2018 to be guaranteed a registration position at Christ the King School).
- If a family wishes to remain at Our Lady of the Rosary School, they may do so, and transportation currently being provided will continue. Mid-year transfers between schools are not supported, consistent with all schools in the Calgary Catholic School District.
- Room is currently available for additional students at Christ the King School, however space will be preserved for all future junior high students from both Christ the King and Our Lady of the Rosary elementary schools.

- If room for future elementary students is not available, they will be redirected to Our Lady of the Rosary School until either room is available at Christ the King School or they enter junior high at Christ the King School. Waitlists will be created as necessary.
- Restricted growth procedures will continue at Christ the King School as necessary.

The district will continue to review population and transportation trends at Christ the King and Our Lady of the Rosary on an annual basis. As necessary, we will engage the community if potential revisions are required in the future.

Thank you for your continued support of Christ the King School.
