

Extra-Curricular Participation Guideline

Students are representatives and are expected to be exemplary role models for other students and for the community at large.

In order for a student to be a member of a school team/club he or she must adhere to academic, attendance and behavioral expectations.

Participation in extra-curricular activities may be limited for the following reasons:

- Poor academic standing in a course
- Absence and lateness in a course
- Behavioral issues

Students will not participate in extra-curricular activities under the following conditions:

- Unexcused absence for any portion of the day of an extra-curricular activity
- While serving a formal suspension

Students may be withdrawn from extra-curricular teams/clubs by the Principal for the following reasons:

- Persistent lack of commitment to academic improvement
- Persistent absenteeism and lateness in a course
- Persistent defiance in adhering to behavioral expectations
- Multiple formal suspensions
