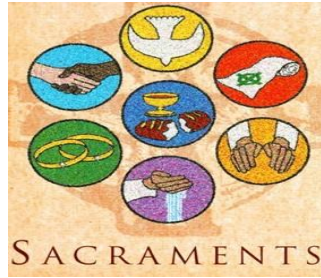
ACCEPTING DONATIONS FOR MOCA'S SE CALGARY COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTRE:
