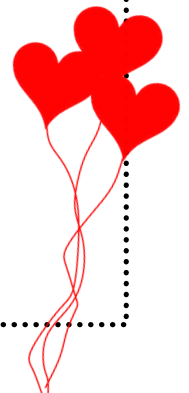
Birthdays are celebrated with a special song and pin! **We** ask if you send a treat for your child's birthday, **please be aware that we have peanut and nut allergies in our class!**
