What are we learning about this month?

Letters and Letter Sounds

We will continue to learn the letters of the alphabet and their sound! This is important for literacy development as we are emerging as readers and writers. Please work on letters at home with your child by name recognition, sound, and printing! This month we will be working on F, G, H, and I!



Author Study: *Dr. Suess*

We will be starting our author study focusing around Dr. Suess! We will be reading books, making crafts, discussing preference, making predictions, and incorporating Dr. Suess into our math! Dr. Suess is a fun author who has great characters, themes, and is a

fun listen! Dr. Suess is a great resource to start discussing main characters and problem/solution.



Playing Restaurant and Being Chefs:

We will be incorporating a restaurant theme into our centers and in our math! We also will be making simple recipes in the classroom!



Community:

We will be exploring the concept of community and the communities we belong to! We are all apart of our Kindergarten community and we all belong in Kindergarten!

Number Sense:

In Early Numeracy we will be counting and creating combination sets of numbers 1 through 4. Additionally we will be subitizing (recognizing at a glance) sets as well. To support your child with developing a number sense look for math around you and talk about the math that they see. For example, counting stop signs, rolling dice, quickly recognizing the number of an item. Students learn best in real life situations, math does not have to be boring!

January 7: Classes Resume

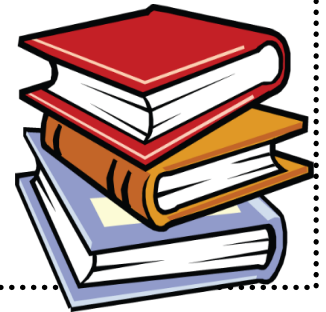


Library Books:
