The Catechism's Teaching on the Family

According to the Catchism's teaching on the family, 'the family is often called the principal cell or building block of human society. Since we are used to thinking about the family as the place where our Catholic faith is handed on and lived, we sometimes pay too little attention to how the family

itself is related to the plan of God revealed in Scripture for the sake of our salvation in Jesus Christ.'

"The Fourth Commandment tells us, "Honor your father and your mother." The Catechism begins its presentation of this commandment by showing us what the tradition of the Church has understood these brief words to contain: "The fourth commandment opens the second table of the Decalogue. It shows us the order of charity. God has willed that, after him, we should honor our parents to whom we owe life and who have handed on to us the knowledge of God. We are obliged to honor and respect all those whom God, for our good, has vested with his authority" (2197). Here we see in concrete form the passage from the "love of God" to the "love of neighbor," beginning with the family which the Catechism calls "the original cell of social life" (2207). " (Levada, 2006)
