Dear Parents and Residents of the St. Albert the Great and St. Marguerite School Communities,

In preparation for the opening of St. Marguerite School the district sought input and feedback from parents with respect to the boundaries of the new school. Based upon this input and feedback, and in keeping with the district priority of sustainable decisions, parents were advised of the boundary decision by letter on June 2015. The letter read, in part, as follows:

- *New Brighton students, from opening school date, will be able to request to attend St. Albert the Great School pending room and resources – no transportation provided.*
- *St. Albert the Great is the designated junior high school for New Brighton boundary area students.*

In order to ensure balanced populations as well as sufficient space and resources for future junior high students from both schools, St. Albert the Great no longer has the room and resources necessary to accommodate requests to register from parents who reside outside the boundary of St. Albert the Great School.
